Reference is made to your application for approval of a 335.48-acre non-standard gas unit in Dakota Producing Interval consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Hanks Well No. 17-D, located 940 feet from the South line and 1755 feet from the West line of said Section 5.
