DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill the above well to approximately 2100 feet to test the Pictured Cliffs formation. Rotary tools will be used from surface to total depth. Casing will be set on top of pay. Pay will be shot with BNC and hole cleaned out with cable tools.

The following casing program is proposed:

Size	Depth	Cement	Remarks
10 3/4"	100'	85 sacks	175% of calculated amount to circulate.
5 1/2"	1975'	75 sacks	100% of calculated amount to fill 600' above shoe.

A copy of any survey taken will be submitted upon completion of well.
