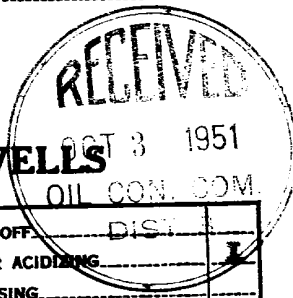

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 5873 ft. (O.L.)

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was drilled to a total depth of 1890 feet with rotary tools. Cable tools moved on location and cleaned well out to bottom.

Well was plugged back with pea gravel from 1890 feet to 1857 feet and slot with 643 gte 3/8" from 1857 to 1777 feet, with a five foot gravel lamp on top and a Cal-seal esp from 1772 to 1737 feet. Shot was detonated at 5:23 P.M. on September 7, 1951. Well was cleaned out to total depth and 1" tubing was landed at 1856 feet.

Well measured 1700 MCF per day after 3 hour blow down through 2" casing outlet with pilot tube through 2" casing outlet on September 25, 1951.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
