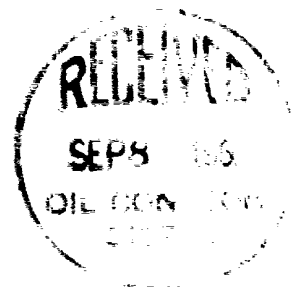

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 349.33-acre non-standard gas unit in the Dakota Producing Interval consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 9 WEST, NMPM
Section 6: Lots 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, 13 and the E/2 SW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Hanks Well No. 16-D, located 1830 feet from the South line and 1760 feet from the West line of said Section 6.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1287, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto, in the event of Dakota proration, based upon the unit size of 349.33 acres.

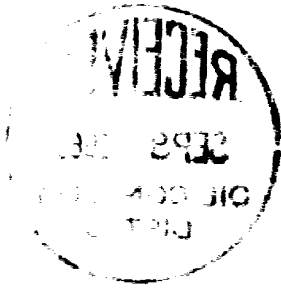
