Details of Plan of Work:

SHOW SIZES, WEIGHTS AND DEPTHS OF PROPOSED CASINGS; ALSO MUDDING JOBS, CEMENTING POINTS AND ALL OTHER IMPORTANT PROPOSED WORK.

This well completed as a small pumper August 22nd, 1926 at total depth 1344 1/2'; plugged back to shut off water with 100# lead wool to 1342. First 24 hrs. test 16 barrels oil, 10 barrels water. Total production approximately 1000 barrels in two months. We propose to drill out lead wool and drill deeper in order to test each lower sand in entire Dakota series, especially because of oil show in Well No. 10 at 1480'.
