In compliance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule No. 112-A, Multiple Completions, Section V -- (c), the El Paso Natural Gas Products Company will run a three hour AOF Retest and Packer Leakage Retest on the Frontier No. 3-B (GD), located in the SW NW/4 of Section 4, Township 27N, Range 11W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This test will commence at approximately 9:30 A.M., Monday, November 23, 1959.

The previous test was not run due to the Gallop tubing not being shut-in for stabilization of pressure. The Gallup was shut-in at 2:00 P.M. on Monday, November 16, 1959.
