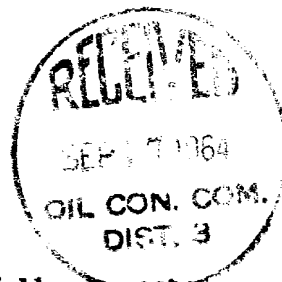

Pan American Petroleum Corporation hereby respectfully requests your approval of a tubingless completion on its E. H. Pipkin No. 10, Basin Dakota Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. This tubingless completion is to be utilized in an existing well as a means of casing repair. The attached map shows the location of the E. H. Pipkin No. 10 in Unit E, Section 1, T-27-N, R-11-W, and the location of other nearby wells in the Basin Dakota Pool. Your attention is specifically directed to the location of E. H. Pipkin No. 9 in Unit N, Section 35, T-28-N, R-11-W, a Basin Dakota Pool well on which your letter of February 27, 1964 approved a tubingless completion in order to effect a casing repair. The proposed tubingless completion on E. H. Pipkin No. 10 will be similar in all respects to that effected on E. H. Pipkin No. 9.

E. H. Pipkin No. 10 was completed as a Basin Dakota Pool gas well on March 21, 1961. As may be seen by the attached sketch of the well, 4½-inch casing was set at 6452 feet and the well was selectively perforated and stimulated for completion in the Dakota formation. The 4½-inch casing was cemented by the two-stage method with the stage tool set at 2071 feet just below the Pictured Cliffs zone.

A leak has occurred in the 4½-inch casing opposite the Mesaverde interval (3400-4100). As shown by the attached sketch of the well, it is proposed to repair this casing by running a full string of 2-7/8-inch tubing inside the existing 4½-inch casing, land it just above the Dakota perforations, cement it to the surface. The mechanical condition of the well following this repair is shown on the attached sketch.

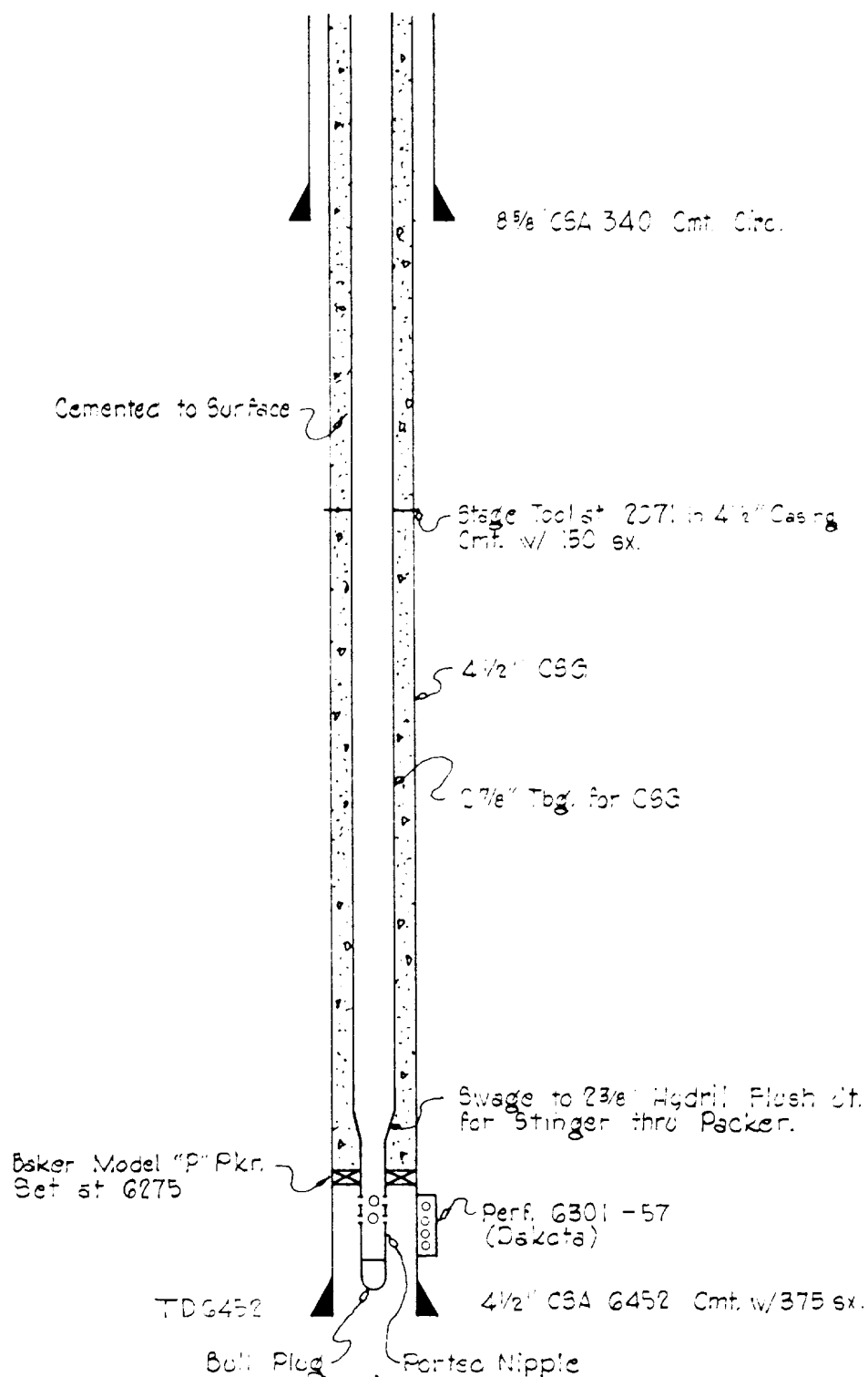

BASIN DAKOTA POOL

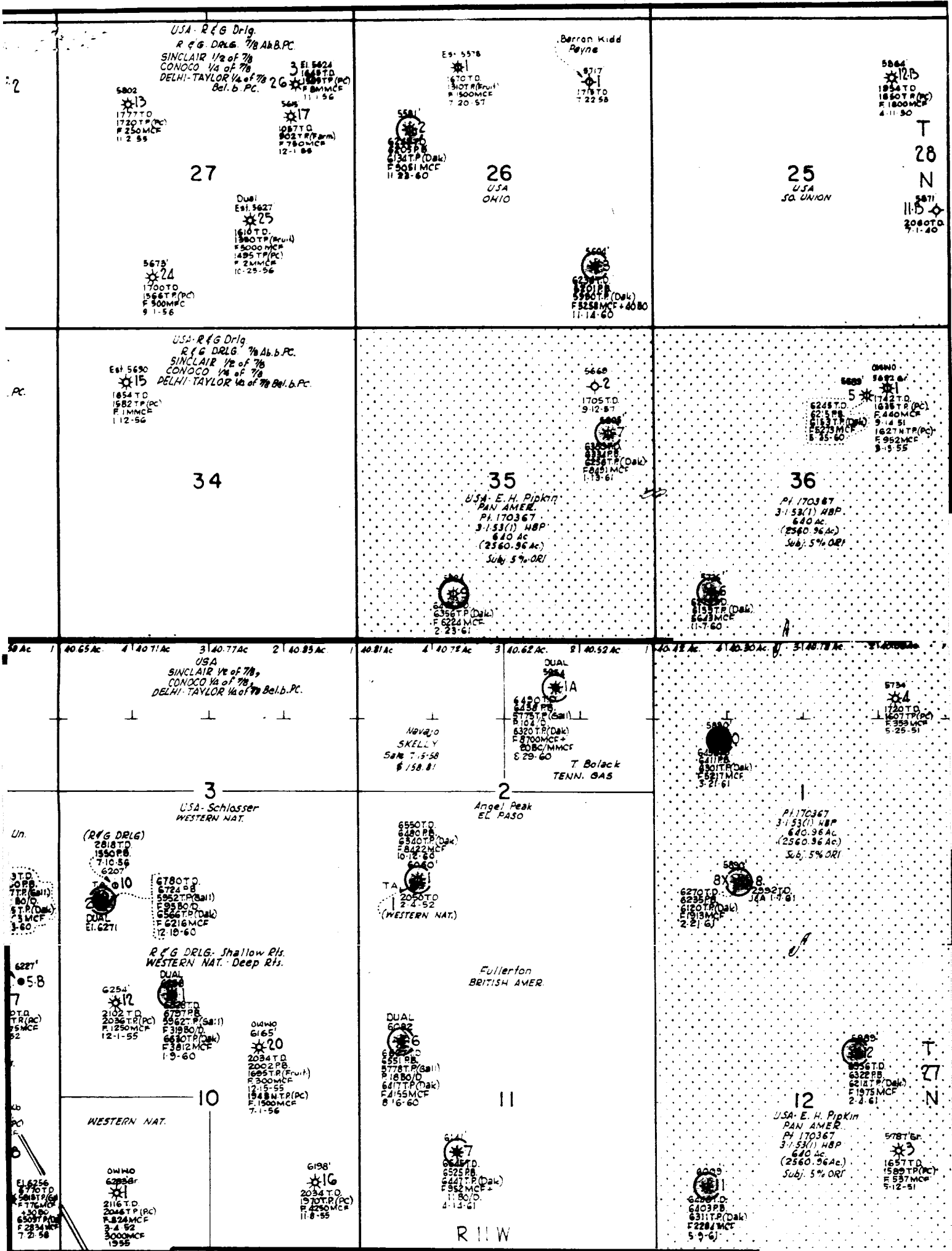
