## Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated September 15, 1964, wherein you request authority to complete your E. H. Pipkin Well No. 10 located in Unit E, Section 1, Township 27 Morth, Range 11 West, San Juan County, New Maxico, as a tubingless completion to produce gas from the Basin Dakota Gas Pool through a full string of 2-7/8 inch casing which is to be run inside the existing 4-1/2 inch casing and comented from the Baker Model "P" packer set at 6275 feet to the surface.
