Reference is made to your application for approval of a 187.23-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 6, Section (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-128-C, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 187.23 acres.
