DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded July 2, 1951.

On July 2, 1951, 9" casing was landed at 118 feet with 75 sacks cement. Cement circulated to surface. Plug down at 2:21 P.M., July 2, 1951. At 2:30 P.M., July 3, 1951, casing and water shut-off were tested with 300 lbs. for 30 minutes without drop in pressure. Thirty-one feet of solid cement was drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested with 300 lbs. for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure during this test. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
