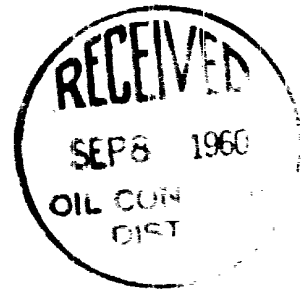

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 178.84 acres.

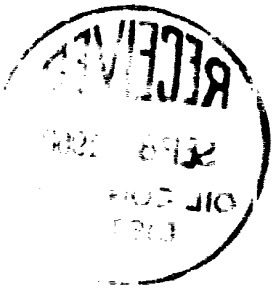
