DETAILS OF WORK

Propose To: Set 300' of 13 3/8" surface casing and cement to surface.

Drill 12 1/2" hole to approximately 100' below Pictured Cliffs formation. Reduce hole to 7 7/8" through Dakota formation. Run 4 1/2" production casing to approximate total depth of 770'. Run 2 7/8" tubing next to 4 1/2" casing through Pictured Cliffs formation to approximate depth of 3250'. Cement Dakota stage with 300 sk., Pictured Cliffs stage with 100 sk., second stage with 100 sk.

Perforate, frac and run 2 3/8" tubing to Dakota formation. Perforate and frac Pictured Cliffs formation.

NE 1/4 and E 1/2 of Section 5 dedicated to well
