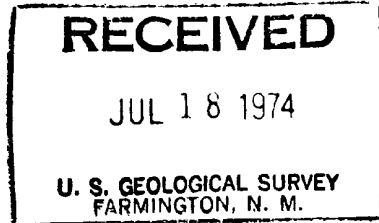

On 5-4-74 pulled the 1-1/4" tubing and set 3-1/2" casing at 1892' with 200 sacks Class "A" cement with 6% Gel and 2 pounds Tuf Plug per sack followed with 50 sacks Class "A" Neat cement. Tested casing with 3300 psi OK. Spotted 250 gallons 7-1/2% HCl. Perforated interval 1853-60' with 2 SPF. Pumped a 3500 gallon pad of water with 1% KCl and 10 pounds Gel per 1000 gallons. Injection rate 10 BPM at 3000 psi. Sand-water fraced with 25,000 pounds 10-20 sand and 15,000 pounds 8-12 sand and 35,000 gallons water, treated as above. Breakdown pressure 3000 psi with maximum pressure 3100 psi and average 2500 psi. AIR 33 BPM. Cleaned up well and returned well to sales line. Repair completed 5-23-74 with production before repair zero and after repair 230 MCFD.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
