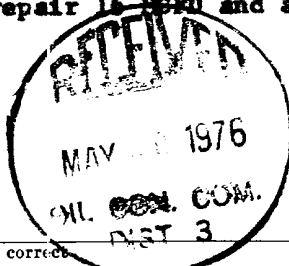

Moved in service unit 2-26-76 and pulled 1" tubing. Ran 3-1/2" casing and set at 1903'. Circulated hole with 1% KCl water and cemented with 100 sacks Class "B" with 2 pounds medium Tuf Plug per sack on 2-27-76. Tested casing with 3000 psi OK. Ran Cement Bond Log. Circ hole with 1% KCl water and spotted 250 gallons inhibited 15% HCl across perf interval. Perforated 1830-1839' and 1842-1860' with 2 SPF. Loaded hole and broke down with 2,500 gallons frac fluid, consisting of 1% KCl water with 5 gallons HOWSCO suds per 1,000 gallons water, 20 pounds WG-7 per 1,000 gallons water, 90 gallons inhibited 28% HCl per 1,000 gallons water, 30% water by volume & 70% nitrogen by volume. Nitroflued with 1003 SCF nitrogen per barrel water. Fraced with 25,000 pounds 10-20 sand and 12,500 gallons frac fluid. BDP 1300, maximum treating pressure 2400 and average treating pressure 2000. ISIP 1300. AIR 20 BPM. Shut in well to stabilize. Ran tubing, tagged sand at 1857' and cleaned out to PBD 1892'. Ran 1-1/4" tubing and landed at 1874'. Cleaned up well with 15,000 pounds SCF nitrogen. Reconnected well to sales line on 3-17-76. Production before repair 16 MCFD and after repair 87 MCFD.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
