Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Bolack "B" Well No. 3 (PM) to be located 790 feet from the South line and 2200 feet from the West line and in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 33, Township 28 North, Range 8 West, Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the SW/4 of said section.
