8-18-85 Move on location and rig up. Pulled 145 jts. 2 3/8" tbg. Ran 7" cement retainer, set @ 3632'. Squeeze cemented open hole with 100 sks. Class "B" with 4% gel, 1/4 cu.ft. gilsonite, (180 cu.ft.), followed by 50 sks. Class "B" with 2% calcium chloride and 10% sand (62 cu.ft.). Pressure tested casing to 1000 psi, ok. Temperature survey on original casing job showed Ojo Alamo formation to be covered. Did not squeeze cement Ojo Alamo.

8-19-85 Drilled out to 3742'. Ran knuckle jt. and sidetracked hole. Now drilling ahead with gas.

8-23-85 Reached TD of 4881'. Logged well. Ran 120 jts. 4 1/2", 10.5#, K-55 casing, 4868' set @ 4880'. Float collar set at 4867'. Cemented with 150 sks. Class "B" with 4% gel, 1/4 cu.ft. gilsonite, 0.6% Halad-9 (270 cu.ft.) WOC 18 hours. Top of cement by temperature survey @ 1600'.

8-24-85 PBTD 4867'. Pressure tested to 4000 psi, ok. Perf'd 4550', 4560', 4598', 4617', 4622', 4644', 4658', 4678', 4698', 4704', 4712', 4744', 4794', 4808' with 1 spz. Frac'd with 69,000# 20/40 sand and 87,060 gallons treated water. Flushed with 3000 gallons.
