DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill & dual complete a well in the Pictured Cliffs formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs formation & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde & a production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Estimated Total Depth 4600'.

Casing Program:

10-3/4" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface

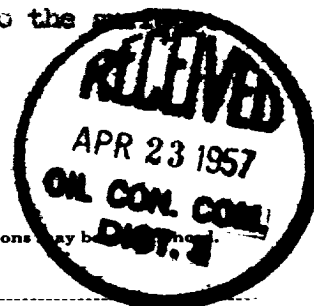
7-5/8" at 2270' with 250 sacks cement.

5-1/2" liner at 4600' with 300 sacks cement.

The SW/4 of Section 30 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs.

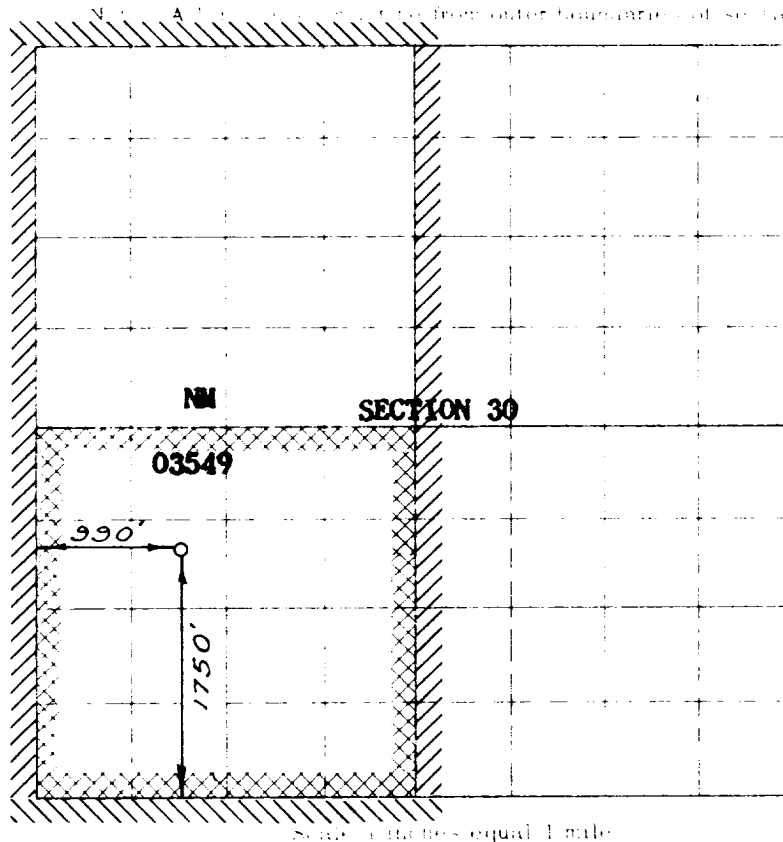
