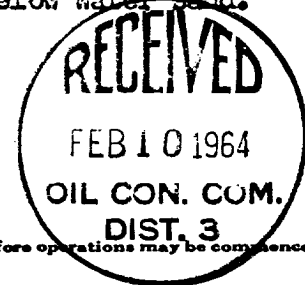
DETAILS OF WORK

Above well was drilled to Pictured Cliff, Total Depth 2213. Pictured Cliff non-commercial.

Plugged for gas purposes and converted to water well in the following manner. A 40 sack cement plug placed at the bottom of the 5 1/2" pipe, shot and recovered as much as possible. Hole mudded up to 600' below water sand. 40 sack cement plug. Top of the plug at 2050'. 1740' of 5 1/2" recovered.
