Now, on this 3rd day of January, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds: (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations; (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offsen acreage have been duly notified; and That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices. IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Reid Well No. 23 located in Unit L of Section 17, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, MMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce yas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively. PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A. PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packerleakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem rescessary. DONE at Santa Me.
