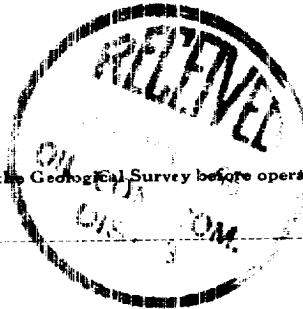

## DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded June 12, 1956. Set 179' of 8 5/8" casing at 109 with 110 sacks cement. Tested for 30 minutes with 500 lbs. pressure, no leaks. Drilled cement plug June 24, 1956. Tested for 30 minutes with 500 lbs. pressure, no drop in pressure.
