ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on January 6, 1960, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Daniel S. Nutter, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 27th day of January, 1960, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel S. Nutter, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant is the owner and operator of the Jones 4-A Well, located in Unit B, Section 13, Township 28 North, Range 8 West, NEPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) That through inadvertence the subject well, a shut-in transfer well, for a certain period of time was assigned no allowable or was assigned an allowable based on a non-current deliverability test.
- (4) That due to this error and the subsequent assignment of allowable on a retroactive basis, the subject well was under-produced some 125,142 MCF as of November 30, 1959, a portion of which is subject to cancellation on January 31, 1960, unless the applicant is given an additional six-month probation period in which to make up the under-production on the subject well.

Now, on this day of January, 1960, the Commission,
a quorum being present, having considered the application, the
evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel
B. Walker, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required
by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the sub-
ject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant is the owner and operator of the
Jones 4-A Well, located in Unit B, Section 13, Township 30 North,
Range 3 West, New Mexico, San Juan County, New Mexico.

(3) That although inadvertence the subject well, a trans-
former well, for a certain period of time was assigned an allow-
able or was assigned an allowable based on a non-current deliver-
ability test.

(4) That due to this error and the subsequent assignment
of allowable on a retrospective basis, the subject well was under-
produced some 125,163 MCF as of November 30, 1959, a portion of
which is subject to cancellation on January 31, 1960, unless the
applicant is given an additional six-month production period in
which to make up the under-production on the subject well.

(5) That the requested relief should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant be and the same is hereby given until July 31, 1960, to make up the aforesaid under-production on the Jones 4-A Well, located in Unit B, Section 13, Township 28 North, Range 8 West, NEPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
