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- 1. A packer leakage test shall be commenced on each mittiply completed well within seven days after actual completion of the well, and annually thereafter as prescribed by the order authorizing the multiple completion. Such tests shall also be commenced on all multiple completions within seven days following recompletion and, or chemical or flacture treatment, and whenever remedial work has been done on a well during which the packer or the tubing have been disturbed. Tests shall also be taken at any time that communication is suspected or when requested by the Commission.
- 2. At least 72 hours prior to the commencement of any packer leakage test the operator shall notify the Commission in writing if the exact time the test is to be commenced. Offset operators shall also be so notified.
- 3. The packer leakage test shall commence when both z hes of the dual completion are shut-in for pressure stabilization. We find shall remain shut-in until the well-head pressure in each mass stabilized, provided however, that they need not remain shut-in more that s ven days.
- 4. For Flow Test No. 1, one zone of the dual completin shall be produced at the normal rate of production while the other zone consists shall be continued for seven days in the case of shall be continued for seven days in the case of a sale well in Note: 11, on an initial packer leakage test, a gas well is being flowed to the atom; ere due to the lack of a pipeline connection the flow period shall be taken mouts.
- 5. Following completion of Flow Test No. . , the well small again be shutten, in accordance with Paragraph 3 above.
- 6. Flow Test No. 2 shall be conducted even though roll eak was indicated during Flow Test No. 1. Procedure for Flow Fest No. 1 is to be the same as for Flow Test No. 1 except that the previously goal red zone main shut-in while the zone which was previously sat -.a is produced

- 7. Project as for gap-rone tests must be measured on each zone with 3 deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: 3-hour tests: immediately prior to the beginning of each flow-period, at fifteen-minute intervals during the first hour thereof, and at hourly intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. 7-day tests: immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, at least one time during each flow period (at approximately the midway point) and immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Other pressures may be taken as desired, or may be requested on wells which have previously shown questionable test data.
- 24-hour oil zone tests: all pressures, throughout the entire test, shall be continuously measured and recorded with recording pressure gauges, the accuracy of which must be checked at least twice, once at the beginning and once at the end of each test, with a deadweight pressure gauge. If a well is a gas-oil or an oil-gas dual completion, the recording gauge shall be required on the oil zone only, with deadweight pressures as required above being taxen on the gas zone.
- 8. The results of the above-described tests shall be filed in triplicate within 15 cays after completion of the test. Tests shall be filed with the Acter District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on Northwest New Mexico Packer Leakage Test Form Revised 11-1-58, with all deadweight pressures indicated thereon as well as the flowing temperatures 1gas zones only) and gravity and GOR (oil zones only). A pressure versus time curve for each zone of each test shall be constructed on the reverse side of the Packer Leakage Test Form with all deadweight pressure points taken indicated thereon. For oil zones, the pressure curve should also indicate all key pressure changes which may be reflected by the recording gauge charts. These key pressure changes should also be tabulated on the Ironi of the Packer Leakage Test Form.

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
