Dear Fred:

You have inquired about five wells which have shown production upon which you have never received an allowable supplement. I have checked and found the following to be true concerning these wells:

Basin Dakota Pool

Aztec Oil & Gas Co., Largo Federal #1, L-34-27N-8W - connected 1-27-67. No test has been submitted. Operator has been contacted and is now testing.

Aztec Oil & Gas Co., Culpepper Martin #5, M-22-32N-12W - connected 12-30-66. No test has been submitted. Operator contacted and is now testing.

Blanco Mesaverde Pool

Aztec Oil & Gas Co., Largo Federal #1, L-34-27N-8W - connected 1-27-67. No test has been submitted. Operator has been contacted and is now testing.

Tenneco Oil Co., Jicarilla C #4, F-24-26N-5W - connected 3-20-67. This well is more than one mile from the present Blanco Mesaverde Pool boundary. A1 is making a pool extension and a supplement will follow.

South Blanco Pictured Cliffs

Continental Oil Co., AXI Apache J #12, K-5-25N-5W - connected 3-22-67. You should by now have supplement #499 which we mailed last week giving this well an allowable.
