The El Paso Natural Gas Products Company is making application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for an administrative approval of a dual completion. The well, our Frontier Pool Unit No. 1-E (GD) is located 1850 feet from the East Line and 790 feet from the South Line of Section 4. Township 27N, Range 11W, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The well is located within one mile of a similarly dually completed well.

By the Order R-1214, concerning dual completions, we must have approval of the offset lease owners of the dual completion. According to our records you own the lease in the SE/4 of Section 4, Township 27N, Range 11W, which was communitize i with El Pase Natural Gas Products Company for the drilling of this well, the Frontier Pool Unit No. 1-E (GD).
