DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled 12-1/4" hole from surface to 235' KB. Rigged up and ran 7 joints of 8-5/8" 24# J-55 8-1/2 lbs. casing open end, landed at 234' KB. Cemented with 175 sacks Best cement with 2 percent calcium chloride. Top plug pumped to 210' KB. Good returns to surface. Job completed at 1030 PM 2-14-61.
