

THE APPLICATION OF THE BRITISH-AMERICAN OIL PRODUCING COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS FULLERTON WELL NO. 8 LOCATED IN THE SW/4 NE/4 OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF OIL FROM THE GALLUP FORMATION ADJACENT TO THE KUTZ-GALLUP OIL POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) The British-American Oil Producing Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 7, 1961, for permission to dually complete its Fullerton Well No. 8 located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 14, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Kutz-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 27th day of March, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, The British-American Oil Producing Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Fullerton Well No. 8 located in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 14, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Kutz-Gallup Oil Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.
