Administrative Order TX-15

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of August 14, 1962, wherein you request authority to complete your Federal Fullerton Well No. 11 located in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 14, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, with 4½-inch OD non-upset casing and produce the Dakota hydrocarbons through said casing string as a tubing-less completion.

Inasmuch as you expect that the Dakota will produce with a gas-liquid ratio in the neighborhood of 100,000 to one, there should be no production problem or waste encountered by your proposed completion.

British-American is, therefore, hereby authorized to complete and produce the subject well in accordance with the procedure outlined in your letter of August 14.

The Commission does reserve the right, however, to review this matter at any time that it appears waste may be resulting from the proposed method of production.
