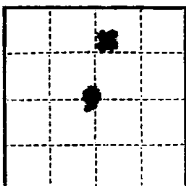

It is our intention to abandon this well in the following manner: Cement plugs from 4650 to 4700', 4700' to 4750', 4750' to 4800', 4800' to 4850', 4850' to 4900' and from 4900' to surface. Intervals between cement plugs will be filled with sand. A regulation dry hole marker will be placed in top of surface casing. Pipe will be filled and location cleared.
