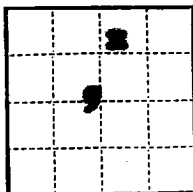

DETAILS OF WORK

Well plugged as follows: Cement plugs from 4800' to 4900'; 3900' to 3750'; 2800' to 2700'; 700' to 600' and from 30' to surface. Intervals between cement plugs will be filled with mud. A regulation dry hole marker placed in top of surface casing, pits filled and location cleared.
Ready for inspection.
