Spudded 5-24-62 w/rotary tools and drilled to TD 1405' RB. Ran 45 joints 5 1/2" casing, landed at 1405' RB and cemented w/300 sacks. Drilled to TD 1448' RB w/cable tools. Perforated 5 1/2" casing 1393' - 1396' w/4 shots per foot. Set bridge plug @ PBTD 1398' RB. Ran tubing and submersible pump. IPP - 15 BO & 326 BWP. Gas TSTM. Completed as Dakota pumping well from 1393' - 1396' RB.
