07-24-76 Cut off stuck tubing at 3920' and pulled. Set 7" retainer at 3669'. Tested 7" casing to 1100#, OK. Squeezed open hole with 202 cu. ft. cement. WOC:

07-25-76 Perf'd squeeze hole at 1225'. Set retainer at 1099'. Squeezed through perf with 148 cu. ft. cement. WOC. Drilled retainer at 1099' and good cement at 1225'. Tested casing to 800#, OK.

07-26-76 Drilled retainer at 3669' and cement to 3784'. Started drilling sidetrack hole at 3784'.

07-28-76 Total depth 4786'. Ran 152 joints 4 1/2", 10.5#, K-55 production casing, 4776' set at 4786'. Float collar set at 4769'. Cemented with 248 cu. ft. cement. WOC 18 hours. Top of cement at 2925'.

07-30-76 PBTD 4769'. Tested casing to 4000#--held OK. Perf'd 3779', 3788', 3842', 4011', 4020', 4070', 4082', 4109', 4130', 4141' with 1 shot per zone. Frac'd with 45,000 20/40 sand and 45,000 gallons water. No ball sets dropped. Flushed with 2520 gallons water.

Perf'd 4296', 4306', 4316', 4328', 4361', 4378', 4388', 4408', 4422', 4454', 4466', 4484', 4494', 4556', 4614', 4698', 4740' with 1 shot per zone. Frac'd

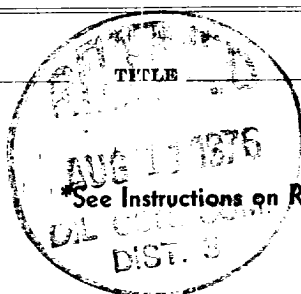

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of packing of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.

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
