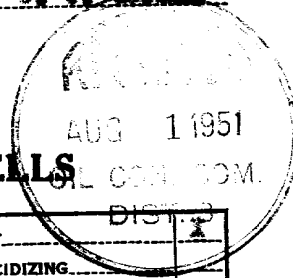

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded July 29, 1951.

On July 29, 1951, 9" casing was landed at 116 feet with 75 sacks cement. Cement circulated to surface. Cement plug down at 1:00 P.M., July 29, 1951. At 1:30 P.M., July 30, casing and water shut-off were tested with 600 pounds pump pressure for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Twenty-five feet of solid cement was drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested with 600 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure during this test. Drilling operations were resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
