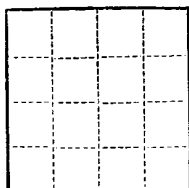

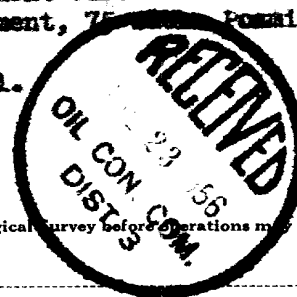

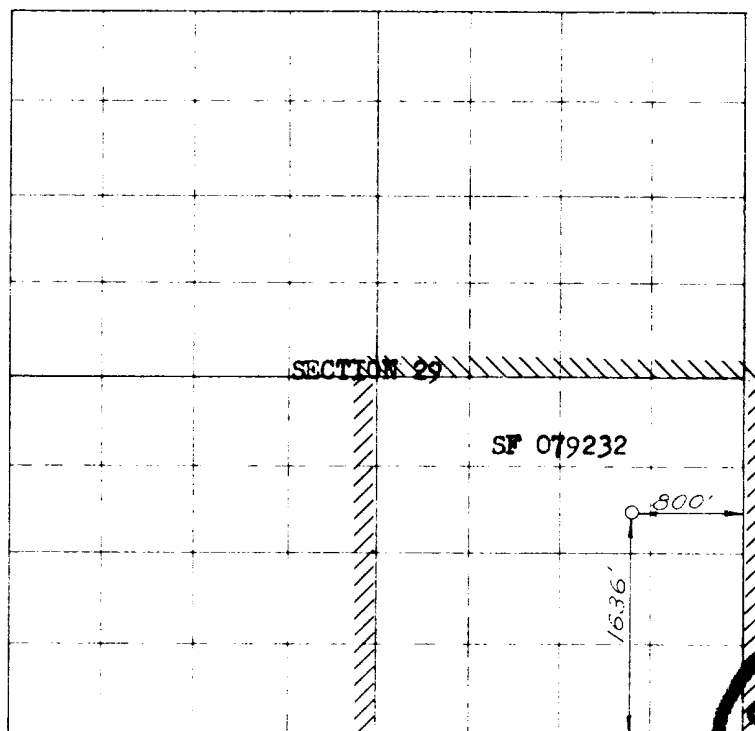

(1882 PLAT)

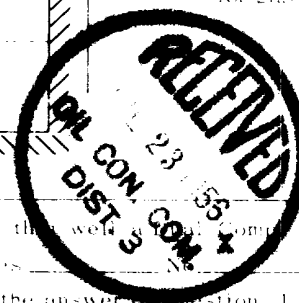
