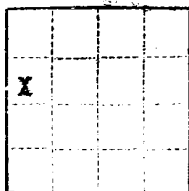

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded on November 13, 1956, and 9-5/8" hole drilled to 98'. A 13-3/4" hole was reamed to 65' - but it was necessary to shut down on November 16th due to heavy snows making it impossible to reach location.

On March 7, 1956 again rigged up, and after reaming to 98.5' RKB, set 3 joints (89') of 9-5/8" OD 32# casing at 98.5' with 70 sacks cement. Circulated cement to surface and moved off, March 8, 1956.

Will continue drilling with rotary rig at later date.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
