Dear Sir:

Drilling operations on the subject well for week ending December 1, 1945, as follows:

Squeezed 20 sacks cement into Tocoto Sand back of 8 5/8-inch casing - pumped down by Haliburton.

Drilled cement plug from 595 to 606 feet. Tested for water shut-off - making two barrels water per hour. Squeezed 60 more sacks cement into Tocito Sand back of 8 5/8-inch casing - pumped down by Haliburton.

Total depth - 925 feet.
