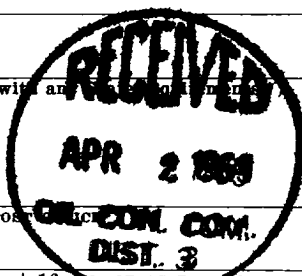

Instructions

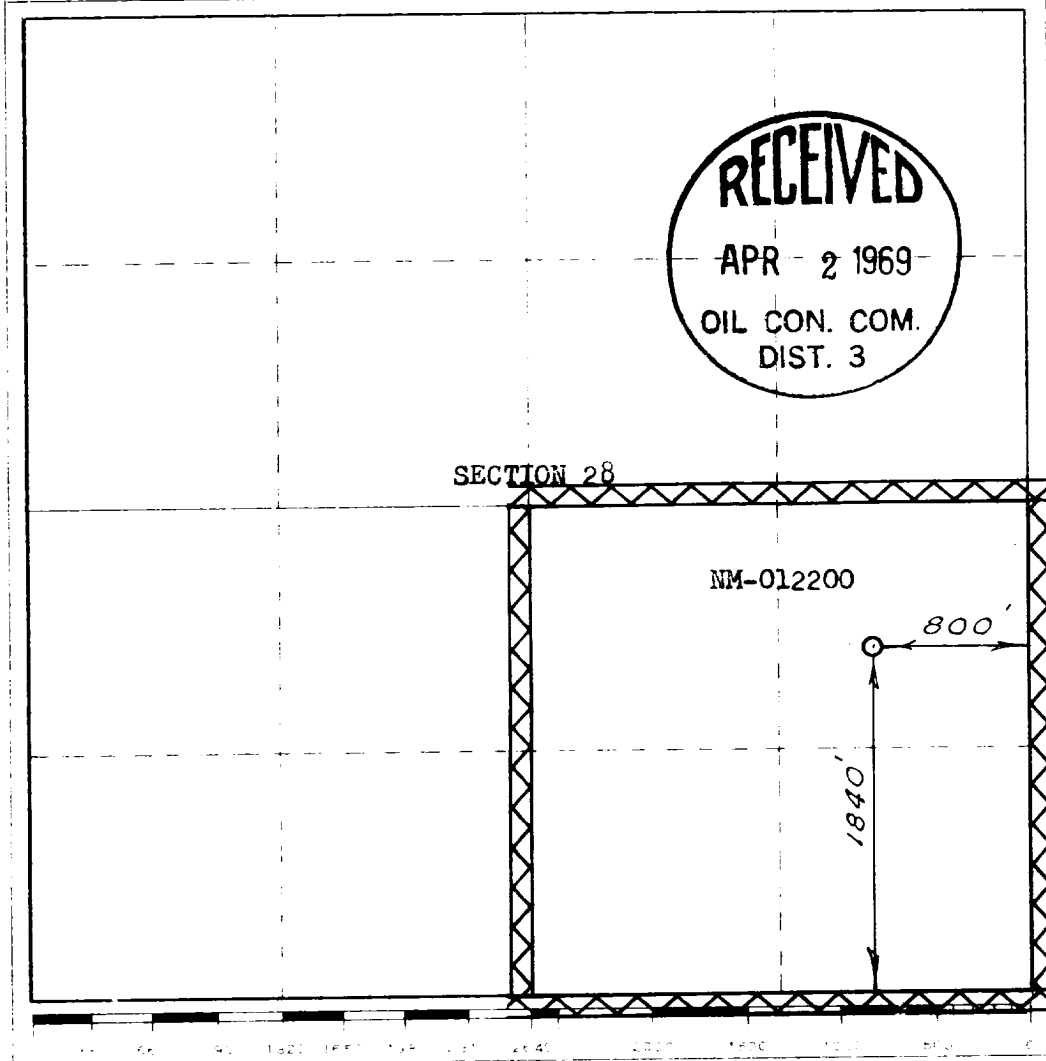
