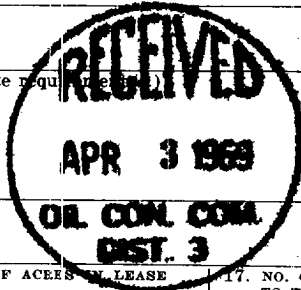

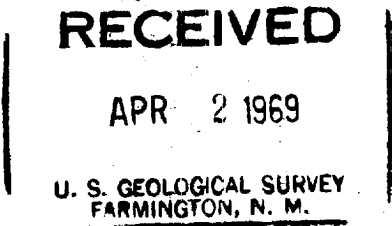

Instructions

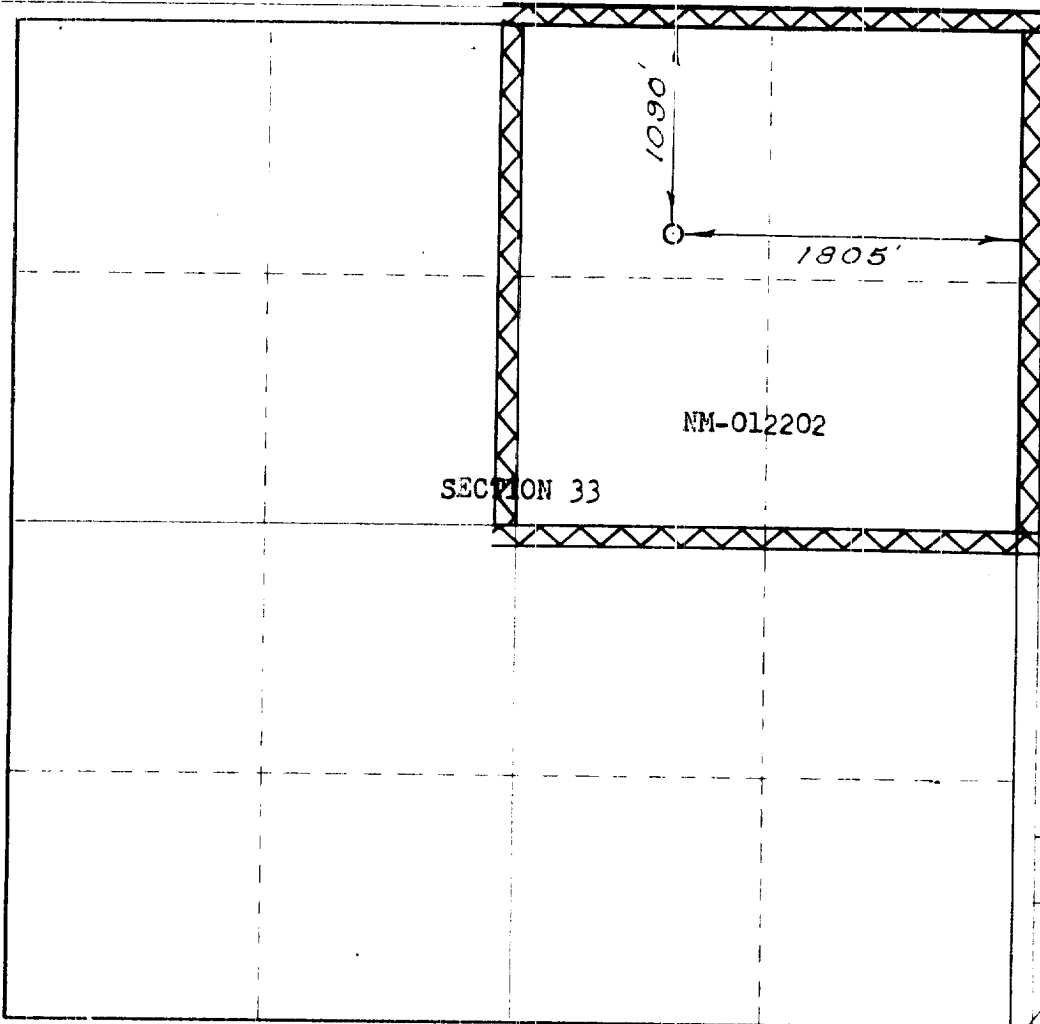
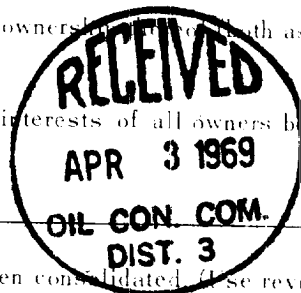
