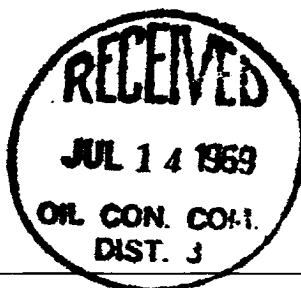

On 5-28-69 spudded well, drilling surface hole.

On 5-29-69 completed surface hole and ran 4 joints 8 5/8", 24#, K-55 casing (123') set at ground level w/65 sacks of cement circulated to surface. W.O.C. 12 hours, held 600# 30 minutes.

On 6-24-69 T.L. 3200', ran 107 joints 2 7/8", 6.4#, J-55 casing (3269') set at 3200' w/150 sacks of cement. W.O.C. until completion.

On 7-7-69 P.B.T.D. 3270', perf. 3227-3237' w/24 holes, sand water frac w/25,000# 10/20 sand, 25,200 gal. water. Flushed w/840 gal. water. No ball drop.
