

THE APPLICATION OF WYNN AND BROOKS
FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1897

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Wynn and Brooks made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 16, 1969, for permission to dually complete its Federal "D" Well No. 1, located in Unit G of Section 22, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 5th day of November, 1969, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Wynn and Brooks, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Federal "D" Well No. 1, located in Unit G of Section 22, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

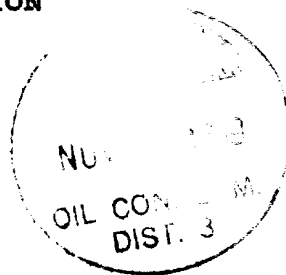
That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall cause packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
