Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated August 16, 1990 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Whitley Well No. 10 which was drilled in 1970 and completed in the Basin Dakota Pool at a standard gas well location 1850 feet from the North line and 850 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 17, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Dakota zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, is unorthodox. Further, the W/2 of said Section 17 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
