Dear Mr. Fullop:

We have received copies of Federal Application for Permit to Drill for your Table Mesa #1, #2, #3 and #4 wells located in Sections 3 and 9 of Township 27 North, Range 17 West and Section 34, Township 28 North, Range 17 West. Each of these locations is non-standard according to our spacing rules in that they are closer than 330 feet to the quarter-quarter section lines. The locations, as staked, can only be approved for production after Notice and Hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe. I am sending you the notification to afford you the early opportunity to make application for a hearing prior to the time that the wells have been completed or to change the locations to standard locations.
