It is intended to add the Fruitland Coal interval in the subject well and commingle the production downhole with the Pictured Cliffs. An application has been made to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division authorizing the commingle. The workover will consist of the following:

MOL&RU. Set RBP @ 2885'. PT csg. Perf Fruitland coal from 2728-2873'. Stimulate the Fruitland w/80,000 gal. N2 foam and 125,000# 20/40 sand. Flow back frac fluid and clean well. Pull RBP and land tubing @ 2930'. Put well back on production. Release rig.
