Spotted 240' of cement across shooting point and Point Lockhart from 2240' to 2000'. Set 150' plug across bottom of P.C. from 1500' to 1650'. Set 150' plug across top of P.C. from 1150' to 1300'. Spotted cement in top of surface and erected dry hole marker. Cleaned location. This work was completed on 3-18-1976.
