





Introduction

The Division of Conservation Archaeology of the San Juan County Museum Association and Eastern New Mexico University recently completed an archaeological clearance survey of National Resource Lands under the jurisdiction of the Bureau of Land Management to be impacted by the scheduled drilling of one oil well in San Juan County, New Mexico, by Dietrich Exploration Company, Incorporated. The required field work was accomplished on August 20, 1975.

The survey project was initiated at the request of, and under contract with Dietrich Exploration Company, Incorporated.
