

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, R & G Drilling Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 10, 1976, for permission to dually complete its Marron Well No. 42-A located in Unit C of Section 22, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Chacra formation adjacent to the Largo-Chacra Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 30th day of March, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations:
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, R & G Drilling Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Marron Well No. 42-A located in Unit C of Section 22, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Chacra formation adjacent to the Largo-Chacra Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
