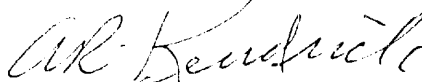

THIS WELL IS TO REMAIN SHUT DOWN AND ALL OPERATIONS MUST BE SUSPENDED UNTIL THE REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION HAVE BEEN COMPLIED WITH AND WRITTEN PERMISSION GRANTED TO RESUME OPERATIONS.

ANY VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER BY ANY PERSON OR PERSONS IS PUNISHABLE BY FINE AND COURT ACTION AS PROVIDED BY LAW UNDER THE STATE OIL CONSERVATION ACT OF 1935, SUCH FINE NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS PER DAY FOR EACH AND EVERY DAY OF SUCH VIOLATION AND FOR EACH AND EVERY ACT OF VIOLATION.
