Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 1-32 Navajo, located 660' FSL and 2150' FSL sec. 32, T. 27 N., R. 19 W., on Navajo Tribal lease NOC-C-14-20-4158, San Juan County, New Mexico.

On December 9, 1982, we wrote to you requesting a Subsequent Report of additional perforating to be done on the well. You subsequently submitted a request for extension of time because the work had not been completed.

The Notice of Intent was approved by this office on March 5, 1982, 10 months ago. Being that no work has yet been done and, according to your latest Sundry Notice, the uncertainty of the Helium Plant taking methane gas, the approval of March 5, 1982, is hereby cancelled, as per your request on the phone on January 6, 1983.

You are hereby advised to submit a new Sundry Notice of Intent to perforate the Barker Creek zone upon determination of the plant accepting methane.

Your Sundry Notices dated December 17, 1982, are herewith returned that were inadvertently approved. That approval is void.
