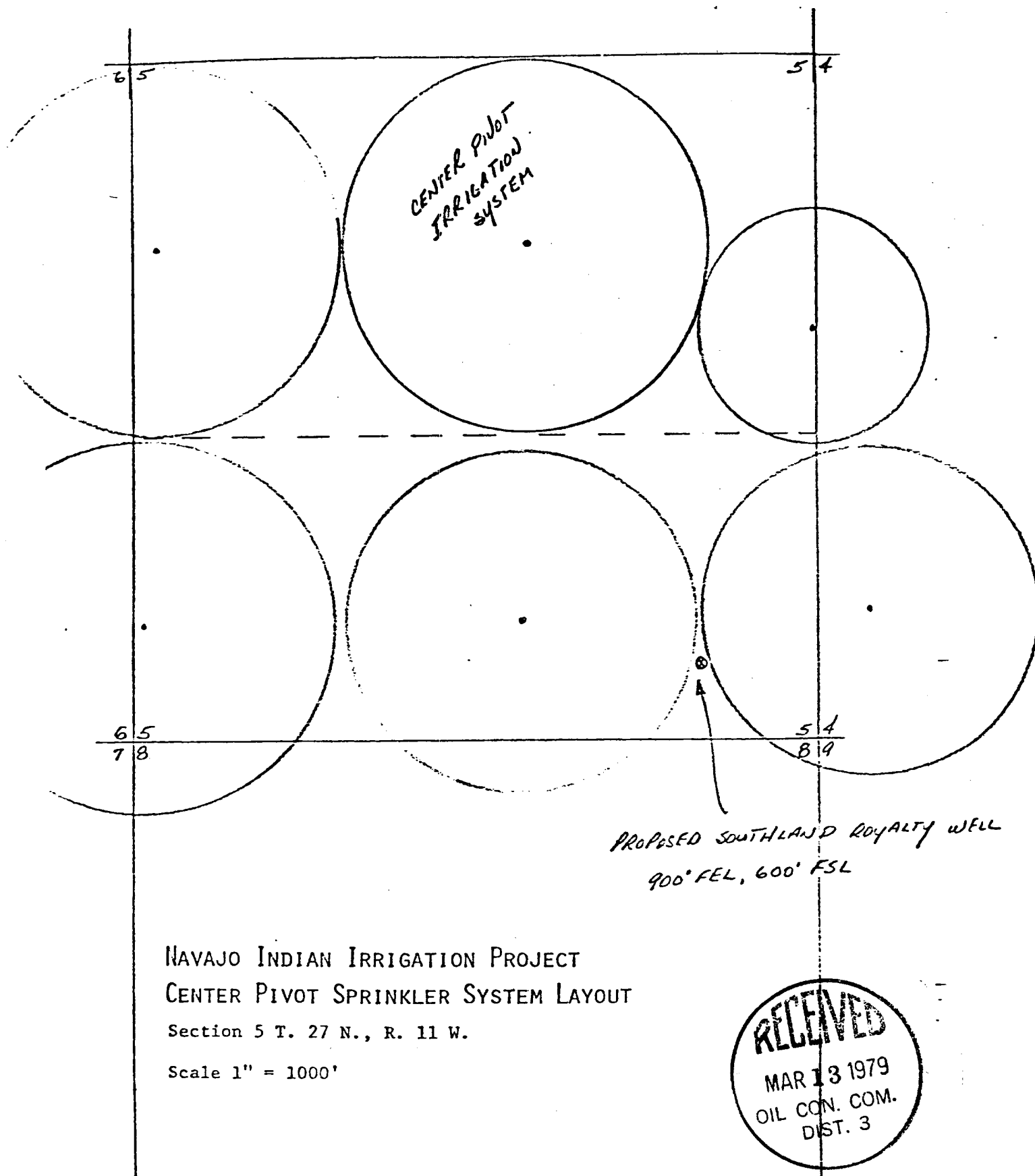

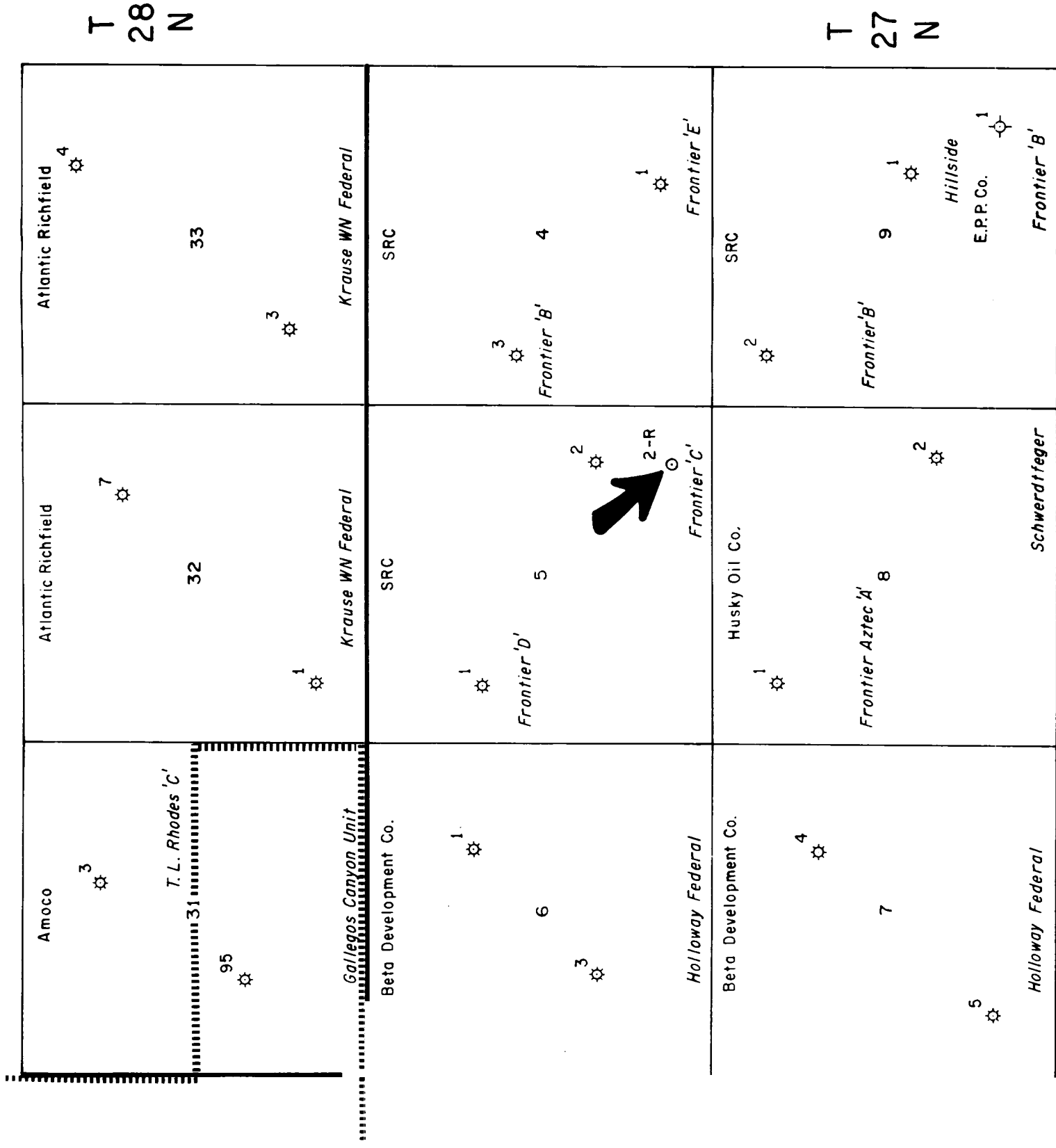
NAVAJO INDIAN IRRIGATION PROJECT
