Now, on this 10th day of October, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from such offsetting operators;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Supron Energy Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Navajo Indian B Well No. 5M located in Unit E of Section 30, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

 $\underline{\mbox{IT IS FURTHER ORDERED}}$. That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


