

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southland Royalty Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on February 16, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Frontier "E" Well No. 1-E located in Unit G of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of oil from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Kutz-Gallup Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

MAY 5 1981 OIL CON COM. DIST. 3 of 1 Now, on this 21st day of April, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- M. / (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112–A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant—with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southland Royalty Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Frontier "E" Well No. 1–E located in Unit G of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of oil from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Kutz-Gallup Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.

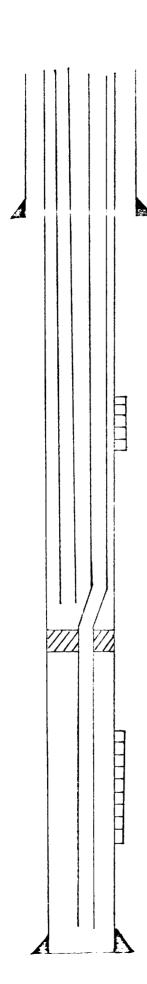
